

NOTICE TO BIDDERS

Sealed proposals will be opened and read by the Purchasing Office of the City of Bayonne, New Jersey in the Council Chambers of the Municipal Building, 630 Avenue C, Bayonne, New Jersey at 10:00 AM (prevailing time) Tuesday, January 6, 2015.

PROPOSALS FOR: EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES AND EMERGENCY DISPATCH SERVICES

All bid proposals must be submitted in accordance with the form of Bid Proposal Form , Plans and Specifications and Instructions to Bidders (collectively, the “Bid Documents”), which are available to prospective bidders at the City Purchasing Office located in the Municipal Building, 630 Avenue C, Bayonne, New Jersey.

All bidders must include the mandatory items set forth in N.J.S.A. 40A:11-23.2 and required by the Bid Documents. The failure to submit any one of such mandatory items shall be deemed a fatal defect that shall render the bid proposal unresponsive and that cannot be cured by the governing body.

All submissions must be signed by the bidder and submitted on approved forms in sealed envelopes, bearing the name and address of the bidder on the envelope and plainly endorsed and as follows:

“EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES AND EMERGENCY MEDICAL DISPATCH SERVICES”

Proposal Guaranty: The Proposal shall be accompanied by a proposal guaranty, which shall consist, at the bidder’s option, of either a bid bond or a certified check payable to the City of Bayonne. The proposal guaranty shall be in the sum of not less than \$20,000.00. Any bid bond submitted shall be posted by a recognized surety company licensed to do business in the State of New Jersey. A form of bid bond is annexed hereto.

Return of Proposal Guaranty: The proposal guaranty of a bidder whose bid is to be considered by the City of Bayonne will be retained until such time as the City of Bayonne executes a Contract with the successful bidder. The proposal guaranty of a bidder whose bid is not to be considered for award by the City of Bayonne shall be void and such bidder’s proposal guaranty will be returned by the City of Bayonne within five days after award of the contract.

The Municipal Council reserves the right to reject any and all bids and to increase the quantities of materials. Bidders may not withdraw their respective bids for a period of sixty (60) days of receipt of bids as provided in Chapter 53 of the Public Laws of 1977.

BIDDERS ARE REQUIRED TO COMPLY WITH THE CURRENT REQUIREMENTS OF P.L. 1975, C. 127 (AFFIRMATIVE ACTION) N.J.S.A. 10:5-31 *ET SEQ.* and N.J.A.C. 17:27;

ALL BIDS MUST BE PRESENTED BY THE BIDDER OR AN AUTHORIZED REPRESENTATIVE AT THE ABOVE STATED TIME. BIDS SENT BY MAIL WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED.

ALL BIDS MUST COMPLY WITH P.L. 1999, c.39, (MANDATORY ITEMS FOR BID SUBMISSION) N.J.S.A. 40A:11-23.2.
