Dear Valued Customer:

This letter is to notify you that PSE&G will be upgrading the electric and Gas systems in your neighborhood. The planned upgrades will enhance the electric transmission system's reliability, while helping to ensure safe electrical and gas services to residents and businesses in Bayonne and neighboring communities.

The current table below outlines the dates and locations where PSE&G crews will be working. The construction work will include both overhead and underground work. Please note that work hours may vary depending on permitted schedules, special events and holidays.

Gas Construction	Avenue C, between W21 st through W25 th	Night work (7pm - 5am)
Electric (Overhead) Construction	Orient St, Evergreen St., Linnet St., Oak St. and Cottage St.	Day work (8am – 5pm)
Electric (Underground) Construction	Broadway, 49 th through 55 th Ave C Between 49 th through 55 th St.	Day work (7am – 5pm) Day work (7am – 5pm)
Electric (Overhead) Construction	Avenue E 23 rd St. and 26 th St.	Day work (8am – 5pm)

Some aspects of this activity may result in unavoidable noise, traffic adjustments as well as road closures. As with any construction project, you may experience an increase in traffic, loud noise, and presence of heavy equipment and machinery.

Safety is our highest priority. All material and equipment will be left on site and will be safely coned off. Therefore, it is essential that you and everyone using your property, including children and pets, refrain from going near our construction work zones.

When work is complete, we repair roads with temporary pavement until the project is complete and the ground settles. Final restoration may depend on the weather conditions, size of the project, time of year or at the request of the town. PSE&G will then have their contractors restore roads with permanent paving in accordance with town/county ordinances and paving requirements.

Should you have any questions, please call us at 1-877-462-0005. PSE&G is coordinating with the Bayonne Police Traffic Unit to minimize any inconvenience. Please abide by the Emergency No-Parking signs, as they will be posted 48 hours before work is scheduled to begin on each street. "Please move or be prepared to move immediately, any vehicle parked within the posted zone."

Thank you for your understanding and patience as we improve electric service and reliability for the region.
