**The City of Bayonne has contracted with LEW Environmental to facilitate compliance with the NJ Lead-Paint Law.**

**Why Did I Get This Notice?**

If you're a single-family home, your property may be flagged as a potential rental as the tax billing address differs from the property address. For multi-family homes, properties are flagged with the assumption at least one-unit may be rented. Various circumstances can cause a property to appear as a potential rental. The City of Bayonne has partnered with LEW Environmental to assist in verifying accurate records.

**New Jersey Lead-Paint in Rental Units Compliance**

Municipal records indicate your property located at: <<Property Address>> may be impacted by the State of New Jersey's Lead Safe law, N.J.A.C. 5:28A and action is required.

Under the provisions of N.J.A.C. 5:28A, New Jersey is mandating periodic inspections for single-family, two-family, and multiple dwellings, with exemptions for units built after 1978, seasonal rentals, and those certified lead-free. The law requires landlords to remediate any identified lead-based paint hazards and obtain lead-safe certifications.

**Exemptions**

Properties constructed after 1978, seasonal rentals, or those with prior lead-free certification are exempt. Owners of multi-unit buildings registered with the DCA for over 10 years may also qualify for an exemption.

*Rental properties located in the City of Bayonne must have inspections scheduled by **May 31, 2026**.*

**UNDER STATE LAW, PROPERTY OWNERS WHO FAIL TO COMPLY WITH THESE NEW INSPECTION AND CERTIFICATION REQUIREMENTS COULD RECEIVE FINES OF UP TO \$1,000.00 PER WEEK.**
