## **Bayonne Announces Street-Paving and Striping Work for 2021**

Mayor Jimmy Davis announced that contractors are starting street-paving and striping for the City of Bayonne in mid-April. Mayor Davis said, “Maintaining streets is one of the most important responsibilities of local government. The City of Bayonne has put a lot of effort into financing and planning street-paving for the spring and summer of 2021. We have also planned the re-striping (line painting) of most of Avenue C. Our residents should notice significant improvements on many streets throughout the community during 2021.”

4 Cleanup, the paving company, will be resurfacing numerous streets from April into the summer of 2021. Those streets include: West 1<sup>st</sup> Street from Kennedy Boulevard to Humphreys Avenue; Dodge Street from Broadway to Orient Street; Newman Avenue from West 2<sup>nd</sup> Street to West 7<sup>th</sup> Street; West 7<sup>th</sup> Street from Kennedy Boulevard to Avenue C; North Street from Kennedy Boulevard to Avenue C; Linden Street from Kennedy Boulevard to North Street; West 8<sup>th</sup> Street from Kennedy Boulevard to Avenue C; Avenue A from O’Brien Court to West 16<sup>th</sup> Street; Avenue A from West 18<sup>th</sup> Street to West 23<sup>rd</sup> Street; West 18<sup>th</sup> Street from West Shore Drive to Avenue A; East 16<sup>th</sup> Street from Broadway to Avenue E; East 19<sup>th</sup> Street from Broadway to Avenue E; and East 27<sup>th</sup> Street from Broadway to Avenue E.

Additional streets include: Prospect Avenue from East 25<sup>th</sup> Street to East 30<sup>th</sup> Street; West and East 38<sup>th</sup> Street from Avenue B to Avenue E; West 39<sup>th</sup> Street from

Avenue B to Avenue C; East 39<sup>th</sup> Street from Broadway to Avenue E; West 40<sup>th</sup> Street from Avenue B to Avenue C; West 42<sup>nd</sup> Street from Avenue B to Broadway; West and East 46<sup>th</sup> Street from Avenue C to Avenue E; West and East 47<sup>th</sup> Street from Avenue C to Avenue E; West 51<sup>st</sup> Street from Avenue B to Broadway; and West 52<sup>nd</sup> Street from Avenue C to Broadway.

The street-paving listed above will be financed by municipal capital improvement bonds.

More streets may be paved later in 2021 with funding provided by the New Jersey Department of Transportation (NJDOT). Any additional paving for this calendar year will be announced.

Signs will be posted on streets in advance of paving and related work. Before paving, the old street surfaces will be milled and removed. Any required concrete work will also be completed.

Mayor Davis also announced that striping (line-painting) will take place on Avenue C from 8<sup>th</sup> Street northwards to the City Line. Statewide Striping, the contractor, will paint new crosswalks, lane lines, and other required striping on Avenue C.
