the City commencing as of April 12, 2023 and award an emergency contract to ALL AMERICAN for same pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40A:11-6, for the period commencing as of April 12, 2023 until such time a new contract can be awarded for the receipt and marketing of said Recycling Commodity – Mixed Paper can be awarded pursuant to the Fair and Open contracting procedure and authorizing the advertisement of a Request for Proposals/Qualifications for said services pursuant to said Fair and Open Process.
