

REGULAR MEETING

OF THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BAYONNE, IN THE COUNTY OF HUDSON, NEW JERSEY, HELD IN THE COUNCIL CHAMBER, MUNICIPAL BUILDING, 630 AVENUE C, ON WEDNESDAY, APRIL 17, 2024.

WHEREAS, the City of Bayonne, in the County of Hudson, New Jersey (the "City"), public body corporate and politic of the State of New Jersey (the "State"), is authorized pursuant to the Local Redevelopment and Housing Law, N.J.S.A. 40A:12A-1 et seq. (the "Redevelopment Law"), to determine whether certain parcels of land within the City constitute an area in need of rehabilitation and/or an area in need of redevelopment; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the Redevelopment Law, the Municipal Council of the City of Bayonne (the "City Council") adopted Resolution No. 98-02-04-040, designating the entire City as an area in need of rehabilitation in accordance with N.J.S.A. 40A:12A-14; and

WHEREAS, on November 6, 2019, the Municipal Council of the City of Bayonne ("Municipal Council") adopted Resolution No. 19-11-06-036 designating certain property located at 196-200 Avenue E, which property is identified as Block 458, Lots 7, 8 and 9 on the official tax map of the City of Bayonne (the "Property") as a non-condemnation "area in need of redevelopment" in accordance with applicable New Jersey Law; and

WHEREAS, on September 23, 2020, the Municipal Council adopted Ordinance O-20-8 adopting a redevelopment plan titled "196-200 Avenue E Redevelopment Plan, Avenue E and East 19th Street, Block 458, Lots 7, 8 and 9, City of Bayonne, Hudson County, NJ." (hereinafter the "Redevelopment Plan"); and

WHEREAS, by Resolution No. 23-09-20-066 adopted on September 20, 2023, the Municipal Council has designated Avenue E Lofts Urban Renewal, LLC as "redeveloper", as defined in the Redevelopment Law, of Block 458, Lots 7, 8 and 9 to undertake development, redevelopment, and construction on Block 458, Lots 7, 8 and 9, in accordance with the Redevelopment Plan, as amended, and related improvements; and

WHEREAS, AVENUE E LOFTS URBAN RENEWAL, LLC (the "Entity") is or will be the owner or long-term lessee of property identified on the Tax Maps of the City as Block 458, Lots 7, 8 and 9, which Property is more particularly described by the legal description set forth in the application submitted by the Entity (the "Application"); and

WHEREAS, the Entity is or will be the designated redeveloper of the Property; and

WHEREAS, the Entity proposes to redevelop the Property with a project that will consist of construction of an approximately 12,500 square foot multi-family residential use building, with forty (40) residential dwelling units and residential amenities including a green roof, bike storage room, indoor amenity space, waterfront walkway and a structured parking facility consisting of forty-one (41) parking spaces, as well as related on-site and public improvements, in accordance with the Redevelopment Plan (the "Project"); and

WHEREAS, the Entity submitted an application to the City for approval of an exemption for the Project pursuant to the Long-Term Tax Exemption Law, N.J.S.A. 40A:20-1 et seq. (the "LTTE Law"), which Application is attached hereto as Exhibit A; and

WHEREAS, the City and the Entity reviewed the application and negotiated the terms of a financial agreement pursuant to the LTTE Law (the "Financial Agreement"); and

WHEREAS, the Municipal Council finds that the requested tax exemption will benefit the City and its inhabitants by improving the use of the Property and providing economic

opportunities for residents through construction and permanent job creation, and the benefits would substantially outweigh the costs, if any, associated with the tax exemption; and

WHEREAS, the Municipal Council further finds that the requested tax exemption is important to the City and that without the incentive of the tax exemption, it is unlikely that the Project will be undertaken; and

WHEREAS, the Municipal Council deems it to be in the best interest of the City to pass an Ordinance authorizing the City to enter into the proposed Financial Agreement with the Entity on the terms and conditions stated in the applicable form of Financial Agreement attached to this Ordinance.

WHEREAS, the Entity is or will be the designated redeveloper of the Property; and

WHEREAS, the Entity proposes to redevelop the Property with a project that will consist of construction of an approximately 7,500 square foot multi-family residential use building, with forty-two (42) residential dwelling units and residential amenities including a lounge/multipurpose room, resident storage lockers, rooftop terraces and lounges, a swimming pool and a structured parking facility consisting of forty-four (44) parking spaces, as well as related on-site and public improvements, in accordance with the Redevelopment Plan (the "Project"); and

WHEREAS, the Entity submitted an application to the City for approval of an exemption for the Project pursuant to the Long-Term Tax Exemption Law, N.J.S.A. 40A:20-1 et seq. (the "LTTE Law"), which Application is attached hereto as Exhibit A; and

WHEREAS, the City and the Entity reviewed the application and negotiated the terms of a financial agreement pursuant to the LTTE Law (the "Financial Agreement"); and

WHEREAS, the Municipal Council finds that the requested tax exemption will benefit the City and its inhabitants by improving the use of the Property and providing economic opportunities for residents through construction and permanent job creation, and the benefits would substantially outweigh the costs, if any, associated with the tax exemption; and

Resolution Approving Modification Agreements for Water and Sewer System Improvements.

WHEREAS, the water and sewer infrastructure owned by the City of Bayonne (the “City”) is in need of certain improvements and replacement projects to assure the proper and safe operation of those systems, regulatory compliance and improved service to its users, which improvement and replacements include the following four projects:

- (1) 10th street Water and Sewer Line Improvements. This project involves: replacement and upsizing of both the water and sewer mains on west 10th Street between Avenue A and the Bay; replacement and upgrading of 32 sewer laterals to the adjacent properties as well as water lines from the main to the curb; 13 known lead service lines from the curb to the property and 2 new fire hydrants.
- (2) Ingham Avenue Stormwater Discharge Pipe Improvements. This project involves replacement of a collapsed section of a large system sewer outfall pipe located on private property (Lehigh Marine, a.k.a. Ken’s Marine) at the southern end of Ingham Avenue adjacent to the Kill Van Kull.
- (3) Top 7 Lead Service Line Replacement. This project involves replacement of the 7 lead service lines which have registered the highest readings in the most recent routine testing. This project is independent of the larger, City wide, lead line replacement project and is being done ahead of that project in order to mitigate exposure at these locations. It is also hoped that these replacements will also provide insight into the replacement process to be applied at future properties throughout the City.
- (4) Oak Street Sanitary Pump Replacement. This project involves the replacement of one of the two remaining 2005 sanitary sewage pumps at the Oak Street pumping station. There are three pumps at Oak Street used to pump Bayonne’s sewage to the Passaic Valley Sewage Commission treatment plant in Newark for treatment. One of the three pumps was replaced in 2017 and has operated well since then. The two remaining (2005 vintage) pumps have failed several times a year requiring repair and the rental of a bypass pump (as two pumps are required by the DEP to be operable at any one time). This project would replace one of the older pumps to both achieve regulatory compliance and save repair and rental costs. Additional improvements to the Pump Station will be examined in connection with the design and implementation of the Federal and State mandated Long Term CSO Control Plan project.

And;

WHEREAS, Bayonne’s water and sewer systems are maintained and operated by Bayonne Joint Water Venture, LLC (“BWJV” also referred to as the “Concessionaire”) and Veolia Water Contract Operations, USA, Inc. (Veolia) pursuant to a 40 year concession agreement entered into on December 20, 2012; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to that agreement, water and sewer projects that exceed the required annual capital expenditures to be made by the Concessionaire or any voluntary

financing or other contribution by the City, are to be paid from water and sewer revenue (rate) adjustments as provided in said December 20, 2012 Concession Agreement, pursuant to modification agreements reached under Section 5 of that agreement; and

WHEREAS, modification agreements for each of the above projects have been negotiated and proposed in the form attached hereto; and

WHEREAS, the Director of Municipal Services has recommended adoption of these modification agreements, provided that, the timelines and schedules for performance be adjusted (moved forward) to begin on a date following approval of any such modification agreement by this municipal council and execution by the Mayor, in a form approved by the City Law Director; and

WHEREAS, it is in the interest of the residents of the City of Bayonne to enable these water and sewer system improvements without delay, now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, by the Municipal Council as follows:

1. The above recitals are incorporated herein.
2. The Mayor and Clerk are hereby authorized to execute modification agreements on behalf of the City of Bayonne in accordance with the terms and conditions of the following four agreements attached to this resolution, in a final form acceptable to the Law Director for the City of Bayonne:
