PURPOSE: The City of Bayonne is seeking funding through the State of NJ Urban Parks Program for improvements at the Mayor G. Thomas DiDomenico Park (16th Street Park) located at 375-409 Avenue A and the intersection of Avenue A and W 16th Street in the City of Bayonne, NJ, 07002.

PROJECT SCOPE: The City of Bayonne proposes to renovate the following facilities at Mayor G. Thomas DiDomenico Park: expansion of the boardwalk, two street end access ramps, Spartina/beach grass plantings, fishing pier, supplemental shoreline stabilization, boat ramp reconstruction, and a waterfront walkway.
