AN ORDINANCE AMENDING AND SUPPLEMENTING THE GENERAL ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF BAYONNE, CHAPTER 3 POLICE REGULATIONS

BE IT ORDAINED, by the **Municipal Council of the City of Bayonne**, as follows:

That the Revised General Ordinances of the City of Bayonne, Chapter 3, Police Regulations, Section 3-25, ABANDONED VEHICLES, Subsection 3-25.5 Impounding, be and is hereby amended and supplemented, as follows (additions ****between asterisks**** and underlined, deletions [within brackets] and struck through):

§ 3-25.5[**Impounding**] **Repealed.**

~~[The Chief of Police or any member of the Police Department designated by him is authorized to remove or have removed a vehicle left at any place within the City which reasonably appears to be in violation of this section, or lost, stolen or unclaimed. The vehicle shall be impounded until lawfully claimed or disposed of in accordance with applicable statutes. The Chief of Police, or any member of the Police Department acting for him, shall notify the registered and legal owner in writing by personal service or by certified mail, at the last known address of the owner, of the removal of such vehicle and the reason therefor, and the location of the vehicle. The vehicle shall be retained and impounded until the owner or his duly authorized agent shall have paid the cost of such taking and removal, together with a garage charge not to exceed \$30 for each day the vehicle is retained and impounded. The Chief of Police shall charge a towing fee not to exceed \$50.]~~
